

## YEAR-LONG SPANISH LANGUAGE COURSE

### Placement system

All the students do a placement test at the beginning of each language course.

### Levels

Our language courses follow the levels of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) and the programmes are based on the syllabus of the Cervantes Institute (PCIC).

We offer five language levels, which in turn are then divided into two sub levels. Where students start depends on the time required to pass the different levels:

- **Beginner I** – **A1.1** (MCER)
- **Beginner II** – **A1.2** (MCER)
- **Beginner III** – **A2** (MCER)
- **Elementary I** – **B1.1** (MCER)
- **Elementary II** – **B1.2** (MCER)
- **Intermediate I** – **B2.1** (MCER)
- **Intermediate II** – **B2.2** (MCER)
- **Advanced I** – **C1.1** (MCER)
- **Advanced II** – **C1.2** (MCER)
- **Proficiency** – **C2** (MCER)

### ECTS Credits

With all of the Estudios Hispánicos courses you can obtain academic accreditation of the European Union, based on the European Credits Transfer System, also known as ECTS.



### Evaluation system

The year-long course comprises the autumn and the spring course, and the evaluation at the end will be the following:

Class mark: 20 %

Final exam: 80 %

The mark of the autumn course will be **30 %** of the final mark; the mark of the spring course will be **70 %** of the final mark.

### Attendance

Students must attend a minimum of **80 %** of the classes; otherwise they will be penalised up to a **10 %** in their course mark (class mark + final exam).

### Certificate of achievement

With all the year-long or four-month courses of Spanish language and culture (autumn course or spring course), you can obtain a certificate of achievement of the course if you pass the final exam. This certificate includes the dates and duration of the course, the language level attained and the qualification and credits obtained. The price of the exam is included in the price of the course.



### Certificate of attendance

A certificate of attendance can be requested by the students of the year-long or four-month courses who have not passed the final exam. To be eligible for this certificate, students must attend a minimum of **80 %** of the classes from the beginning of the course until the date they make the request.
